Climber (18 yrs) fell from 1st pitch of climb and sustained a broken leg and dislocated ankle. He was given morphine.

### 2 8 March 1959

### Glaramara - Comb Door

A walker (20 yrs) had slipped on some rocks in a gully and injured his thigh on a rock spike.

#### 3 Force Crag 21 March 1959

Young girl slipped on some rocks and sustained bruising and a cut eye.

### 4 29 March 1959

### Seathwaite Fell

Loose rock came away when a man was climbing. He sustained a broken leg and severely cut hand.

#### 5 22 March 1959

Windy Gap

A boy (15 yrs) dislocated his shoulder. He was given morphine.

#### 6 30 March 1959

# Scafell Pike

A man's foot slipped between 2 rocks on the path near the summit and he fractured his leg.

### 7 1 April 1959

### Glaramara

All-night search in extremely bad weather for a party of 3 who failed to return to their lodgings. They had spent the night behind a boulder.

### 2 April 1959 8

Rescue of a cragfast sheep.

### 9 16 May 1959

An accident to a rock climber.

#### 1 June 1959 10

### **Great Gable - Napes**

A Boy Scout climber fell from a ridge and suffered multiple abrasions and an injured ankle. Morphine administered.

### 11 3 June 1959

### Sty Head

A woman slipped and fell cutting her head.

### 12 13 July 1959

Taylorgill An elderly man slipped off the path and injured his spine.

#### 13 14 July 1959 Troutdale

A man was found wandering around with concussion.

### 14 15 August 1959

Barf

Team called to search for a lost youth. He turned up before the search started.

## 15 16 August 1959 14:30 Pillar Rock - Rib and Slab

Climber (50 yrs) fell 50' from the 4th pitch and sustained a compound fracture to his femur and a dislocated shoulder. He was given morphine.

# 16 22 August 1959 Glaramara - Chapel Fell

Man (30 yrs) walking in gym shoes had slipped and fallen breaking his leg. He was given morphine.

## 17 25 August 1959

## Esk Hause area

Search for 6 boys lost in the mist. Found in Langstrath suffering from hypothermia.

# 18 13 September 1959 Gimmer Crag - Langdale

Leader fell near top of climb and sustained multiple injuries.

# 1913 September 1959Miner's Crag, Newlands

Man fell while climbing and dislodged his 2nd who fell and broke his leg.

# 20 28 September 1959 Black Crag

Solo climber became cragfast.

# 21 1 November 1959 Black Crag

2 climbers became benighted and cragfast.

## 22 31 December 1959 Pillar Rock

Team called to rescue 3 climbers who had been stuck on a climb all night. They had already been assisted by other searchers on arrival of the Team

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
