- * 25th January. Lake Hotel. 13th Annual General Meeting. President - Lt Col Westmorland. Medical Officer - Dr Lyth. Secretary - Mrs V Nixon, Treasurer - J Clark. Quartermaster - D Oliver. Committee - Messrs Nixon, Richardson, Graham, Sandham, Withington, Mrs P Lyth and Mrs E Graham. G Fisher resigned from the Committee, and as Team Leader, on 10th January.

- * Proposed that 6 ice axes be bought.
- * MRC supplied pair of wooden runners (one front and one rear) and some carrying straps.
- * M Nixon suggested that a hard top would greatly increase the comfort and durability of the ambulance.
- * G Fisher offered to give a tragsitz to the Team if they would pay the import duty of £4. Agreed.
- * A press account of a night rescue said that, "A large fire was lit in the mountain to enable the rescuers to see." This, in fact, was light from flares!
- * 47 members.
- * Balance in hand at the end of the year: £149-9-1d.
- * Mountain Search Panel established.
- * There were 25 callouts in 1960.

9 day search for Nicholas Hawkins - fruitless.

2 1960 21:00 Green Gable area

2 brothers set out to climb Great Gable. The younger one (14 yrs) felling tired retraced his steps to Honister but lost his way in the mist and failed to arrive. He was found the next day, cragfast on a ledge on Haystacks.

3 6 March 1960 Shepherd's Crag

A youth (16 yrs) sustained a Colles wrist fracture and back injuries. She was given morphine.

4 4 July 1960 18:00 Barf

A youth (17 yrs) had fallen on the scree and received head injuries and a broken leg. He was given morphine.

5 8 August 1960 Lining Crag, Greenup Edge

A youth (17 yrs) sustained facial injuries. He was given morphine.

6 21 September 1960 Helvellyn

A woman (55 yrs) broke her leg on a lower path. She was given morphine.

7 4 December 1960 Goat Crag

A youth (18 yrs) sustained a hand injury. He was given morphine.
