Boy (15 yrs) in school party slipped on ice, breaking his clavicle.

Boy (18 yrs) in school party with badly gashed leg after scree running on Eel Crag. Another boy had a twisted ankle.

Girl (14 yrs) slipped on snow, falling 130' sustaining bruises and cuts.

Woman (69 yrs) slipped on path sustaining knee injuries.

Boy (13 yrs) with head injuries from falling boulder.

## 8 6 April 1969 14:15 Castle Rock - Via Media

Climber fell 40' and sustained spinal injuries. Cuts, bruises and 2 broken wrists. She was given morphine.

## 9 9 April 1969 13:15 Glaramara - Red Beck Gully

Boy (15 yrs) fell 30' sustaining head and leg injuries.

# 10 11 April 1969 18:10 Force Crag Mine

2 boys (13 yrs & 14 yrs) in school party scree-running on Scar Crags. One sustained head injuries, the other a broken arm.

#### 11 11 April 1969 22:40 Black Crag - Troutdale Pinnacle

2 teachers and 2 boys benighted. Found returning on path.

Climber fell 30' while leading, sustaining wrist and foot injuries.

#### 13 21 April 1969 22:35 Langstrath

4 RAF cadets lost on Duke of Edinburgh's Award Scheme Silver Expedition between Langdale and Wasdale. Found at 0200 hrs suffering from hypothermia in Langstrath.

#### 14 4 May 1969 Walla Craq

Boy (9 yrs) fell 20' into gully, fracturing his skull. He just stopped short of a 600' fall.

## 15 4 May 1969 Cat Bells

Boy strayed from parents on walk. Missing for some considerable time. Found unhurt.

#### 16 4 May 1969 16:00 Wythburn waterfalls, Steel End

Boy in school party with broken femur.

## 17 19 May 1969 Latrigg

Boy (16 yrs) fell 25' when tree climbing, injuring his spine.

## 18 24 May 1969 11:55 Cat Bells

Boy (11 yrs) in school party slipped on path sustaining head and leg injuries.

Man (21 yrs) fell 300' from top of crag in wet conditions - fatal.

# 20 27 May 1969 21:35 Langstrath - Sty Head

Search for inexperienced youth (18 yrs) on his own. Found OK.

#### 21 29 May 1969 14:50 Helvellyn - Brown Cove

Boy (15 yrs) with an epileptic fit fell 30' during an electrical storm sustaining shock and facial injuries.

#### 22 31 May 1969 13:00 Great End - Ruddy Gill

Man (42 yrs) collapsed from a heart attack and died.

## 23 12 June 1969 Gowder Crag

Investigation into report of climber seen falling from the crag. He had been held by his second.

## 24 14 June 1969 19:00 Eagle Crag - Langstrath

Woman (21 yrs) fell 120' descending crag and sustained a broken clavicle, bruises and shock. She was given morphine.

# 25 15 June 1969 13:10 Low Crag - High Crag, Buttermere

Cockermouth MRT on exercise. 1 member killed, another died later, others with pelvic injuries, shock, etc.

#### 26 21 June 1969 6:20 Helvellyn

Woman (23 yrs) with exhaustion on sunrise walk.

## 27 22 June 1969 17:10 Hopegill Head

Man (63 yrs) collapsed from a heart attack and died.

# 28 6 July 1969 1:00 Langstrath

Report of flares seen. Nothing found.

# 29 6 July 1969 18:45 Dock Tarn - Blea Tarn area

3 boys lost on expedition. Found exhausted.

#### 30 12 July 1969

Search of mines after disappearance of local schoolboy. Found unhurt.

## 31 14 July 1969 17:50 Dale Head Crags

Boy collapsed with exhaustion. Brought down by other walkers.

#### 32 28 July 1969 15:30 Castle Craq

Boy (15 yrs) slipped on wet rock and fell 20' sustaining a broken ankle and shock.

#### 33 30 July 1969 12:00 Cat Bells - Manesty path

Man (78 yrs) in a collapsed condition from heat exhaustion.

## 34 1 August 1969 17:25 Ullock Pike

Girl with an ankle injury having slipped in low shoes.

#### 35 11 August 1969 Borrowdale - Hollows Lane, Grange

Girl (19 yrs) slipped while walking in beach shoes and dislocated her knee.

## 36 12 August 1969 Fleetwith Pike

Investigation following report of a cragfast dog. Negative results.

#### 37 17 August 1969 23:00 Dale Head - Buttermere

Search for missing youth separated from his partner. Found at campsite.

# 38 31 August 1969 Ashness

Negative search of gill after call for assistance.

## 39 2 September 1969 Shepherd's Crag

Girl fell while climbing sustaining a broken leg.

# 40 3 September 1969

The Team Ambulance was used to assist at a road traffic accident when the Keswick Ambulance was away from base. Nine casualties conveyed to hospital after a multiple car crash.

# 41 28 September 1969 8:00 Force Crag

Sea Cadet (17 yrs) unconscious with hypothermia.

## 42 10 October 1969

The Team Ambulance was used to assist a road traffic accident when the town ambulance was away from base.

# 43 5 November 1969 18:35 Sour Milk Gill

Youth (20 yrs) collapsed with exposure in Brandreth area. Whistles and cries heard. Party from Ullswater OBMS. Snow conditions.

# 44 13 December 1969 21:00 Black Crag

Party of climbers benighted. Assisted off in bad weather.
